

#### **COMING FROM I-80 TOLLROAD**

Exit 77 ramp ends at intersection of N. Michigan St. and Douglas. From center lane, continue straight onto Douglas Road. Keep to the right, past two round-abouts. At traffic light, continue straight onto Moreau Drive. Sacred Heart Parish Center lot is on the left before the deadend.

#### **COMING FROM THE SOUTH**

Drive north on Michigan St (also called SR933, Bus31 or Dixie Hwy) past Notre Dame on right. Turn right onto Douglas Road. Keep to the right, past two round-abouts. At traffic light, continue straight onto Moreau Drive. Sacred Heart Parish Center lot is on the left before the deadend.

#### **COMING FROM THE NORTH**

Drive south on Michigan St. (also called SR933, Bus31 or Dixie Hwy). Before Notre Dame campus, turn left onto Douglas Road. Keep to the right, past two round-abouts. At traffic light, continue straight onto Moreau Drive. Sacred Heart Parish Center lot is on the left before the deadend.

#### **COMING FROM THE EAST**

Take Douglas Road west. Stay to the right past roundabout at Twyckenham. Stay to the left at the next roundabout. At traffic light, continue straight onto Moreau Drive. Sacred Heart Parish Center lot is on the left before the deadend.
