# Free YouTube Pastel Tutorials

NIPS member **Avon Waters** began a YouTube channel in February, 2024 offering free tutorials for pastelists. He often was asked repeated questions following workshops that he would teach. His solution was to use the YouTube platform to answer the questions proposed by the students. Each 15-30 minutes episode could be paused, stopped, or played over and over. It started just as a supplement to the classes and workshops as a way of not having to constantly repeat himself. But surprisingly, many more than just his students subscribed. As of this writing, the channel has 1,400 subscribers and he averages roughly 100 more each month as others find the topics or discover by word of mouth. Avon states "Funny thing is, now I'm still answering questions about the topics when people leave comments. But that's OK, I learned what others shared with me for free, so I guess it's a way of paying things forward."

Avon thinks there are several kinds of artists. One of which develops a following of collectors and they sell their art to a great set of buyers. These buyers are moved by what the artists creates. Then there are artists who are "an ARTIST'S artist. Their work is bought by other artists who admire this artist's work and want to learn more from him (or her). Avon states that he is an Artist's artist. He thinks there are more of us than there are those who have a stable of collectors in line for their work.

Avon has always enjoyed teaching. He hopes to do live events several times a year where students can sign up, receive a photo source, and everyone can paint along with him as he creates a painting.

This must be his social media year as he also started a podcast called "2 Guys Talk Art". It is for those who don't get to sit around with other artists after a day of painting and talk about creating art.
